Conflict Minerals Statement

To Whom It May Concern:

Service Steel & Pipe, Inc. recognizes the importance of complying with laws of the United States. This letter is specifically related to Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Protection Act of 2010 as enforced by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (“Dodd-Frank”) regarding the use of certain so-called conflict minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries.

According to Dodd-Frank, metals derived from minerals defined as potential conflict minerals include: columbite-tantalite (coltan, niobium and tantalum), cassiterite (tin), gold and wolframite (tungsten) (to the extent such minerals originate from the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries, the “Conflict Minerals”).

Declaration:

No metals derived from Conflict Minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries are used in the production of the steel purchased by Service Steel & Pipe, Inc. . I certify that I have the authority and knowledge to make this declaration.
